

Proposition 65 declaration

Dear Sir or Madam,

California Proposition 65, officially known as the California Safe Drinking Water And Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians (and other business in the state of California) about significant exposures to chemicals that are known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. On August 31, 2016, the State of California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) adopted certain amendments to Article 6, Clear and Reasonable Warnings for California Proposition 65 which become effective on August 30, 2018. For more information on warnings.

There are several GMT-Benelux products that may contain California Proposition 65 listed substances. However, to the best of our knowledge based on information currently available, we believe that those products do not expose its users to such chemical through contact, intake or inhalation as long as they are used and handled accordance with purpose, usage and conditions designated in the normal or foreseeable use intended. As such, these products are not required to have the California Proposition 65 warning labels.
